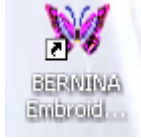


## Lesson # 2: Bernina artista Editor Plus or artista Designer Plus?

The lessons in this workbook are written for both Bernina artista Editor Plus and artista Designer Plus. Toward the end of the book only those people with Designer Plus will have the ability to do manual digitizing and use some of the other options available. If you own Editor Plus you might decide to upgrade on line to Designer Plus. The lessons offered in that section will let you know what Designer Plus is capable of.

Open artista software by clicking on the Butterfly icon

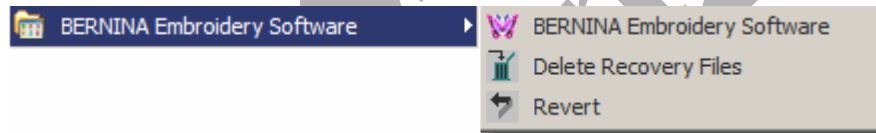


on your desktop.

You can also open the software by going to the bottom left on your computer screen and left click on **Start**.

Click on All Programs.

Select **Bernina Embroidery Software**.

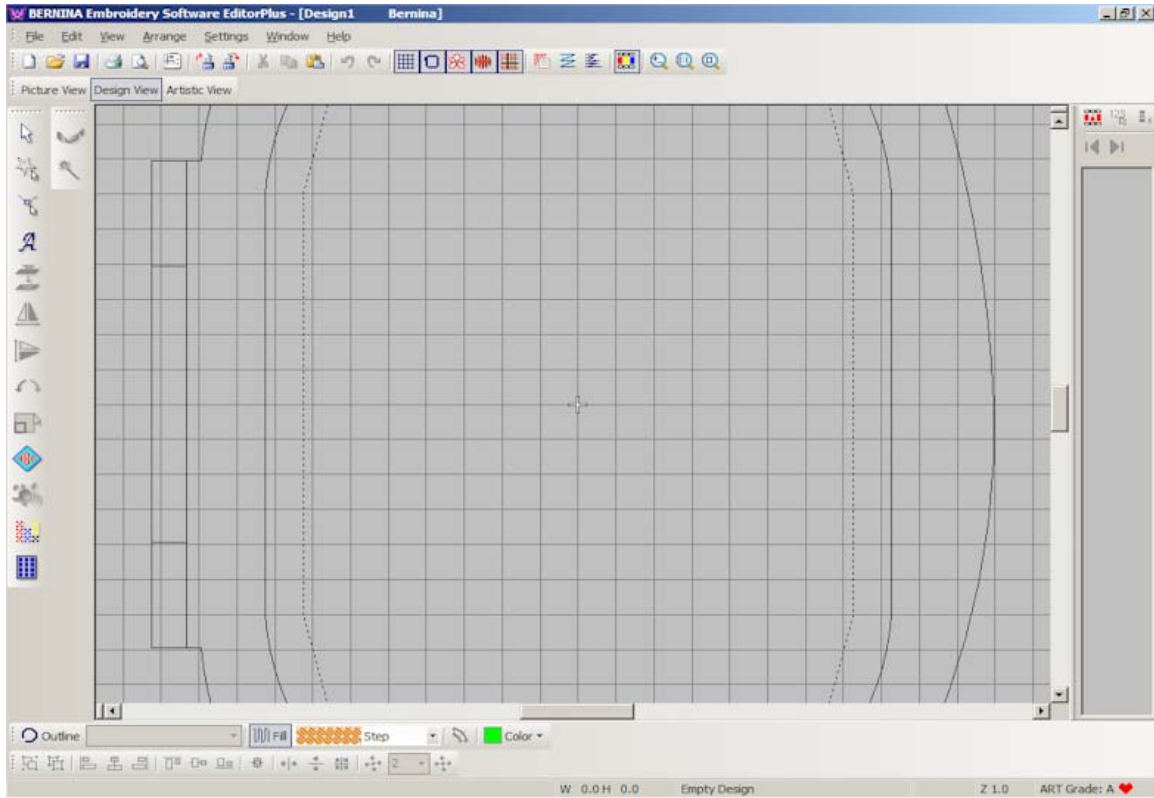


The software takes a few minutes to open so grab a cup of coffee and read all the neat tips that flash while its loading. Why does it take so long? It's a big program with lots of professional features that make it different from any other on the market!

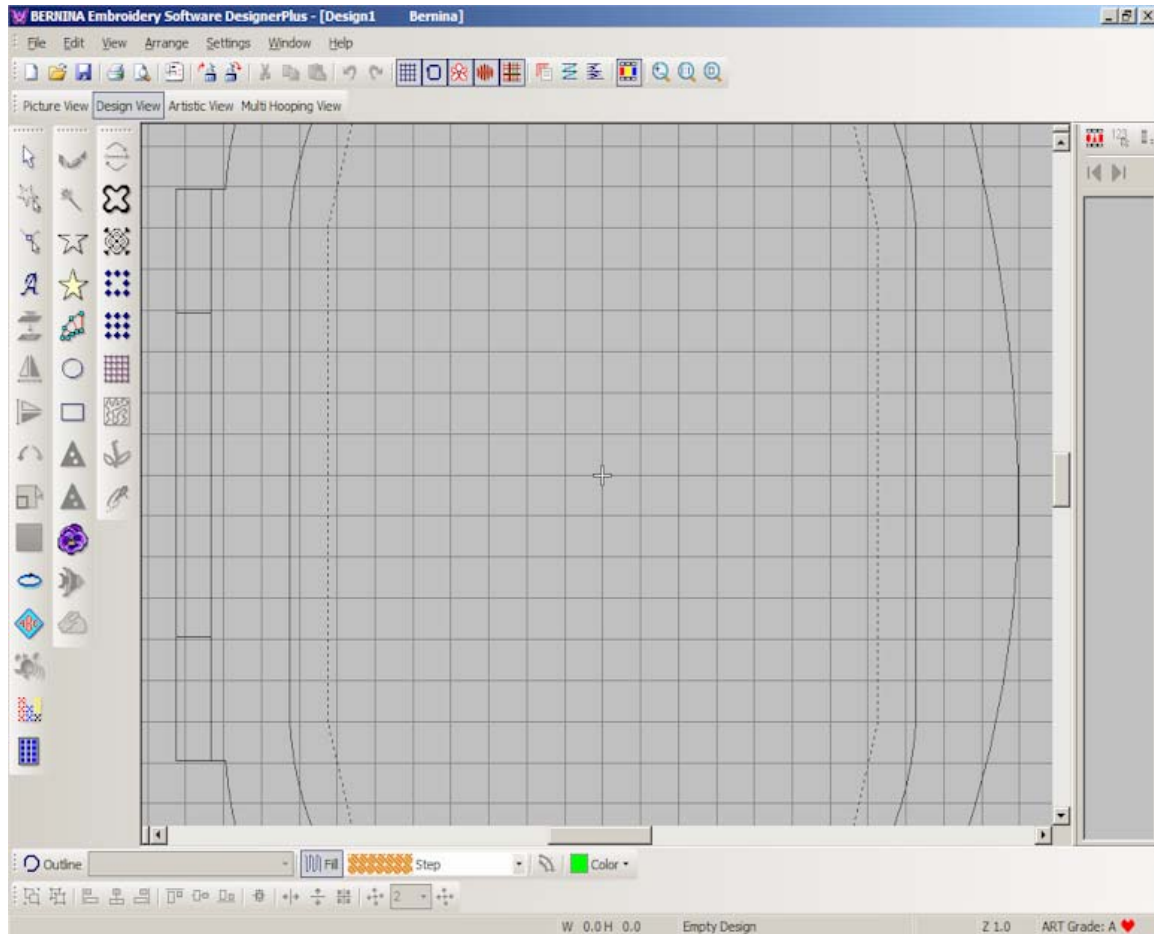
When the software has loaded and opens on your computer screen, you will see the **Title Bar** in blue. The name of the version of software you have purchased is listed.

**Design 1 Bernina** will be in the title bar until you use the screen for a design that you create or open a design in a new page.

If you own Editor Plus you will see the screen below when you open your software.



If you own Designer Plus you will see the screen below when you open your software.



As you progress through the lessons you will use all the drop down menu's, the general toolbar, view modes, and software tools on the vertical toolbar will be explained and used. You should review these tools in the **Quick Start Guide** that came with your software.

All the first lessons will be written with the Editor Plus view. Designer Plus owners will just see more options on their own computer.
